Board members requested Holly to see about getting a trial of the service.
- Holly asked for board feedback about student and county representation on the library board. Board members are confident with their make-up at this time.

Motion by Hietpas, seconded by Wentzel to approve the Full Time Adult Services Librarian Job Description.
