EXPLANATION:

Due to the high cost of radios the department added replacement of radios in the 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) budget which was approved in 2023. This request is to approve the purchase of 5 mobile radios using the CIP budgeted Fire Department Trust Funds for 2025.

BACKGROUND:

The Village of Kimberly Fire Dept was part of a successful Outagamie County wide FY21 Assistance to Firefighters Grant award. The reason for the grant request was due to obsolescence issues with the current radios which prevented batteries and other components from being replaced and maintain the intrinsically safe certification. This certifies the radio is safe to operate in environments where natural gas or other flammable gases are present.

When applying for the grant we submitted to replace our current radios along with additional radios so every seating position on the apparatuses has a radio. This is needed to ensure all personnel have radio communications in the event they are split up from the crew they are operating with.

During the grant writing process, we were informed that we could only use the funds to replace existing radios due to the obsolescence issues, so we reduced our requested quantity to match what we currently have, which is 14 total mobile radios.

When the award was received the grant ceiling limit did not allow all the participating departments to receive their required replacements. It was determined that the funding would allow each participating department to receive half of their applied for quantity. This brought Kimberly's allotment down to 7 radios. These radios were received in 2024.

Bids were received from three vendors by a group representing multiple departments within Outagamie County. The bids were evaluated by the committee for best value and Baycom / Mototola Solutions was chosen as the successful bidder. Along with their bid, Motorola extended the same pricing for two years in the event departments wanted to purchase additional radios outside of the awarded amount as all needs were not met with the grant funds.

The Kimberly Fire Department respectfully requests using the results of the county bid process last year to make the purchase of 5 radios for that same pricing – quote attached.

Recommended Action:

Approve the purchase of 5 Motorola radios for the total price of \$24,999.95 funded by the Fire Department Trust Fund.

EXPLANATION:

Currently the department has two small Android based tablets that are used in the trucks. The current tablets are used for navigating to calls, getting initial dispatch information through the IAmResponding app, performing monthly truck checks and conducting fire inspections within the Village. The current tablets have small screens and do not fit the need of the department as we continue to digitize our workflows.

We are looking to replace these two tablets with larger iPads that are easier to use and provide higher security through the Apple iOS operating system. This will allow for future growth of onscene reports being completed digitally, larger screen for better navigation and dispatch information for the Officer of the truck.

The membership of the Kimberly Fire Department discussed the need for this equipment and a unanimous vote was received to use funds from Fire Department Donation Trust fund to purchase the iPads & accessories for a total cost of \$953.27. The items being purchased are listed below.

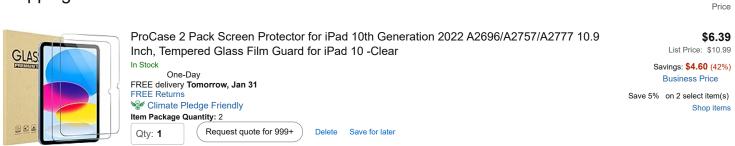

With the upcoming build and replacement of Engine 3521 in 2026, we are wanting to outfit the truck with a 6-radio bank charger that can be designed and mounted into the truck from the

With the upcoming build and replacement of Engine 3521 in 2026, we are wanting to outfit the truck with a 6-radio bank charger that can be designed and mounted into the truck from the outset. This will allow all 6 seats in the rear of the truck to have a radio on a charger in one location. This charger allows the batteries to be properly cycled and prevented from being overcharged, extending the life of the batteries. While the truck is not scheduled to be delivered until 2026, we would like to purchase this charger now, to use in the station to charge and maintain current radios, as we have replaced most radios with newer models through the Outagamie County Radio Grant in 2023/2024 and through the 2025 Capital Improvement Plan.

The old chargers in the trucks do not work for the new radios, but the old radios work in the new chargers. We are short chargers for the old radios as the old bases were hardwired into the trucks 110v shore power system. We now have radios without chargers. This would allow all radios to be charged and properly maintained to prevent damage to the batteries.

The membership of the Kimberly Fire Department discussed the need for this equipment and a unanimous vote was received to use funds from Fire Department Donation Trust fund to purchase the 6-radio bank charger for a total cost of \$1,295.00. See the attached quote.
