A Note from the Director

### 2025 - Celebrating our spaces & places in the VOK

The Village of Kimberly Parks Team maintains 89+ acres of public park lands throughout the Village. We strive to provide a wealth of clean and welcoming spaces with a little bit of something for everyone. A few new and exciting amenities to highlight include the new playground and shelter updates at Verhagen Park, the addition of rental kayaks in Sunset Park, the splash pad at Sunset Beach, and bleacher and field updates at the Sunset Park Youth Diamond.

Our parks continue to be a gathering space for many. From programs like recreational baseball, events like the Great Pumpkin Walk, miles of trails for passive or active recreation and transportation or celebrations like the annual 3rd of July Fireworks show—the parks are a great place to come together and make memories.

Projects and improvements scheduled in 2025 include a trail connection along Marcella Street and Kennedy Avenue from Kimberly Avenue to Cobblestone Lane allowing bicyclists and pedestrians to safely traverse through the Kimberly business park and connect to neighboring accommodations like the CE Trail or sidewalk and bike lane on Kimberly Avenue. Work will begin on a new stormwater pond to the north of Sunset Beach with a mutually beneficial goal of reshaping the landscape of the northern side of the beach footprint. Finally, the second phase of the Cedars Historic Overlook will begin in 2025, transforming one of the last remaining papermill structures into a 4 seasons rentable space and public restroom.

We look forward to seeing you in the parks this year at one of our many seasonal community events, a rec program, a dip at the beach, a kayak paddle on the Fox River, or a quiet walk in the park. The Village of Kimberly truly is a great place to live, learn, work and play.

# YOUTH SPORTS

## Kimberly Recreation Baseball Program

The mission of Kimberly Recreation baseball programs is to develop teamwork, good sportsmanship, and skill development in a fun environment. All leagues are coached by adult volunteers, coaches and participants receive a team jersey. Baseballs, bats, and helmets are all provided - please bring a glove. Players are welcome to use their own equipment if they are more comfortable doing so, cleats are not required. Leagues will start the week of May 12th. Practices are welcome and encouraged but not required. Many teams elect to meet before their scheduled game time each week to warm up together. Season schedules and team information will be sent to all program registrants no later than the beginning of May and available to view on the league software. We need coaches in all leagues, please indicate interest in coaching on your registration form! Not ready to coach a team independently? We always try to buddy coaches up with at least one or two other people, the more the merrier! We host a variety of baseball program for participants as young as 3 up to 13 years of age. Games will be scheduled between Sunset and Roosevelt Parks. All programs and leagues are co-ed. Program updates will be emailed to all participants including team rosters, team name, and coaches information. Emails will be sent after teams are formed in late April. Jerseys will be delivered to the field at your team's first game. If you have specific requests for the season such as a team mate or coach, please include that information in your registration. Rain out information is emailed throughout the season.

## Soccer Tots



This introductory soccer program is sponsored by the Park & Recreation Department and River Surge FC. The program will teach basic skills and provide the participants with an introduction to the fun and exciting game of soccer. This program is open to children age 3 to 4 with program times available at 9:00, 9:35, 10:15, or 10:50 a.m. These 30 minute sessions will be held at Roosevelt Park on Tuesday mornings June 10th - July 22nd having the week of 4th of July off. As the season approaches, any rain out information will be communicated via email with at least an hour's notice before class start time. All participants will receive a t-shirt. Closed toed shoes are required, cleats are completely optional.

## NEW Fall 2025 Into to Flag Football League!

Program includes a six-week season on an adult coached team participating in this non-contact sport, teaching the fundamentals of football. Games are played on Saturdays from September 13th—October 18th with a team meet up week scheduled September 6th to practice and get to know each other. All participants receive a t-shirt. The village provides flag belts for each team, footballs, and kicking tee. Participants are encouraged to wear comfortable, weather appropriate clothing. Closed toes shoes required, cleats optional. Team rosters and schedules will be released in late August via email. Leagues offered for participants ages 5 - 7 (5K - 1st Grade) and ages 7 - 11 (2nd Grade - 4th Grade). We need coaches! Please indicate your interest in coaching on your child's registration.



## Outdoor Archery Exploration

This instructional archery program for beginning archers, available to anyone 9+, offers skill training by a NASP certified instructor with fundamentals from USA Explore Archery, Archery Trade Association: Explore Bow Hunting, Kids on Target from White-tails Unlimited, as well as fun games and activities for archery beginners! Hunting and shooting techniques will be covered along with much more! Our instructor brings all the equipment needed for each week's instruction. Program begins September 13th and concludes October 4th, Saturdays from 10:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. in Sunset Park.



## Hunters Safety Certification Class

A DNR Certified Hunter Safety Program is being offered with highly experienced adult Hunter Safety Instructor facilitation. A class itinerary will be distributed at registration. Participants are required to attend all sessions. Course will be held at Sunset Park, Shelter #1, July 29th and 30th, 5:00 p.m.—8:00 p.m. Field Test Time slots to be pre-scheduled on July 31st at 8 a.m.—10 a.m. or 5 p.m.—8 p.m.

Advanced registration begins: Monday, June 16th at 1:00 p.m. at the Park & Recreation Office 515. W Kimberly Avenue, Kimberly, WI 54136, a parent/guardian must be present to sign the registration form. Early registration is suggested, class size is limited!

## Babysitting Certification Classes

At the end of the course, participants will be trained in CPR, First Aid, AED use and babysitting. Course fee is \$65.00 and includes all certifications and instruction. Please make sure your email is accurate when registering to ensure we can send you the course materials and certification cards!

## Sunset Beach Swimming Facility

Sunset Beach is staffed by Red Cross Certified Lifeguards. Bring your family to enjoy the amenities the beach has to offer including: an all ages splash pad, zero-depth entry shoreline, kiddie slide, water slide, diving well with high and low dive, concessions, family changing rooms, sand beach, sand toys, lounge chairs, and rentable shelter space. We are open every fair weather day throughout the summer. Follow us on Facebook @SunsetBeachSwimmingArea.

## 2025 Sunset Beach Open Swim Hours:

Join us for open swim: Monday - Saturday 12 p.m. - 6 p.m. and Sunday 12 p.m. - 5 p.m. with a water break scheduled from 3:00 - 3:20 p.m. Patrons are welcome to remain in the facility but will need to wait to reenter the water at 3:20 p.m.

## Host your Summer Party at Sunset Beach

Rental of the shelter in Sunset Beach is \$31.65/day for Residents \$36.93/day for Non-Residents, reserved on a first come, first served basis. Beach admission is not included with shelter rental rates.

## Season Pass Swap Week

Season pass holders: enjoy swap week and explore neighboring pools for free! Visit Little Chute, Neenah, Menasha, and Appleton pools during swap week with your Sunset Beach season pass. **July 7th - July 11th, 2025.**

## Bark at the Beach

**New in 2025** - Early Season AND Late Season Bark at the Beach passes. As always, proof of rabies vaccine or village dog license required for participation, no exceptions. Early season passes begin June 9th and allow beach entry for dogs M-F 7 a.m. - 9 a.m., season pass required for entry. Late season access begins August 18th and includes day pass and season pass options. Skip the line and register ahead online! <https://kimberly.recdesk.com/Community/Membership>

## A few things to remember while visiting Sunset Beach:

Sunset Beach is a smoke free facility, please refrain from smoking, including e-cigarettes, within the facility! Carry-ins are permitted, excluding glass containers or alcoholic beverages. Coast Guard approved type I/II/III life jackets including puddle jumpers are permitted on swimmers. The only other swim aid allowed are pool noodles, no water wings or other inflatables. We do have life jackets available in the guard house!

All shelter reservations must be made in person at the Parks & Recreation office at 515 W. Kimberly Avenue or by calling 920-788-7507. Fees may be paid by cash, check, or credit card. A 3% service fee is applied to credit card transactions. Please note that a key for the facilities needs to be picked up prior to your rental date to access the restrooms or kitchen. A credit card is required to be put on file for security deposit. Shelters are booked on a first come first served basis and can be reserved 364 days in advance!
