EXPLANATION:

The Village received notice of claim on May 20, 2025, for water damages and losses to resident basement from storm on July 13, 2024. The claim was submitted to the Village's insurance company, CVMIC, for review on May 27, 2025.

Based on the information received, it is CVMIC's recommendation that under Wisconsin law, a municipality does not face liability unless there is a "known danger" that is compelling enough to warrant specific, non-discretionary action by the municipality. Lodl v. Progressive Northern Insurance Co., 2002 WI 71, 253 Wis. 2d 323, 646 N.W.2d 314. Wisconsin courts have developed a three-step test to determine whether the known and compelling danger exception applies in a given case: (1) whether something happened to create a compelling danger; (2) whether a government actor "[found] out about the danger, making it a known and compelling danger"; and (3) whether the government actor addressed the danger by taking one or more precautionary measures or instead "[did] nothing and let the danger continue." Heuser v. Community Ins. Corp., 2009 WI App 151, ¶¶27-28, 321 Wis.2d 729, 774 N.W.2d 653.

When applying the above rules to this incident, it is CVMIC's opinion that there is no evidence to show any liability on the part of the Village.

In addition, weather records indicate heavy storms on the date of loss. Heavy rainfall could not be foreseen by the Village, and accordingly, this claim can be denied for Act of Nature. Further, Wisconsin State Statute 893.80 states that a notice of a claim is to be made within 120 days after the happening of the event giving rise to the claim. This claim was made 311 days after the event, and is not within the statute.

It is CVMIC's recommendation that the claim be denied. Village staff concur with CVMIC's recommendation.

Recommended action:

Staff recommend that the claim be denied for the above reasons and according to CVMIC recommendation.

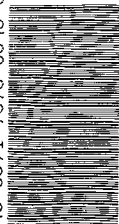

ITEM DESCRIPTION: First Amendment of the Development Agreement – Footworks Dance Company

REPORT PREPARED BY: Sam Schroeder, Community Development Director

REPORT DATE: June 9, 2025

EXPLANATION: Over the last several months, the Village and the owners of Footwork Dance Company (Footworks) have worked diligently to bring forward a development agreement to facilitate the sale and development of the east half of the vacant Kimberly Avenue lots. Most recently, the Village Plan Commission and Board did approve the full site and architectural plans and the certified survey map for the development.

With commercial building plans being submitted for approval, and the owners still desirous of being in the new facility by early fall, the Village and the owners are looking to close on the property in the coming weeks.

Prior to closing, the owners of Footworks have created a separate LLC or limited liability company to keep the business separate from the real estate. Attached herein is a drafted first amendment to the development agreement for Footworks Dance Company by Kim LLC to assign the agreement to Mader Investment, LLC and for the Village to accept this assignment.

This is a standard real estate and development practice

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the First Amendment of the Development Agreement between the Village of Kimberly and Footwork Dance Company, assigning the Developer to Mader Investments, LLC.

**FIRST AMENDMENT
TAX INCREMENT DISTRICT NO. 6
DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT is dated as of the ____ day of June, 2025, by and between, Mader Investments, LLC formerly Footworks Dance Company by Kim LLC, a Wisconsin limited liability company (collectively "Developer"), and the Village of Kimberly, a Wisconsin municipal corporation ("Village").

BACKGROUND RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Village and the Developer, Footworks Dance Company by Kim LLC, executed a Development Agreement ("Agreement") on April 7, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of said Agreement was recorded with the Register of Deeds Office for Outagamie County on April 21, 2025, as Document No. 2336212.

AGREEMENTS

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the Recitals and the promises and undertakings set forth herein, the parties mutually agree to amend the Agreement and covenant as follows:

1. All references to "Footworks Dance Company by Kim LLC" in the Agreement shall be deemed to refer to "Mader Investment, LLC".
2. Except as expressly amended by this First Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Note #128 states "4" sanitary drain...to nearby catch basin".

6" cleanout access is required at change of pipe size to the 2" drain connections at UC Wash Equipment therefore we need to install 6" x 2" reducing wyes and add 6" floor cleanout at end of each branch. If the 4" referenced at Note #128 applies we should install 4"x 2" at connections and 4" floor cleanouts. This would be more economical.

This also applies to the 4" trench drain connection - drawings show 6" drain to 4" throat trench drain.
