EXPLANATION:

At the Village Board meeting on Monday February 2, 2026, Trustees came to a consensus to strike restrictions on the number of "Class A" and Class "A" licenses based on population. As a reminder, these licenses allow for the retail sale of liquor, beer and wine for off-premise consumption. Examples include Kwik Trip, Kimberly Mini-Mart, Dollar General and Festival Foods.

On the same night, the Board discussed the continual use requirement, which is currently in Village Ordinance under Sec. 308-19:

§ 308-19 Continual use requirement.

A. Use standard. Under the authority of § **125.10**, Wis. Stats., as amended from time to time, each and every holder of a Class "B" combination license shall be required to keep the licensed premises **open for operation a minimum of five days per week throughout the term of the license** (except that the licensed premises may be closed for remodeling from time to time, and except that the licensed premises may be closed for reasonable periods of time when the owner/operator thereof takes vacation; periods of remodeling shall be an exception so long as remodeling is actively pursued during the period when the licensed premises is closed).

B. Violation. Upon violation of Subsection **A** above, the license shall be revoked according to the procedure set forth under § **308-18** of this article, or in the alternative, the license shall be nonrenewed according to the terms and provisions of § **308-18** of this article.

Following the Village Board discussion on Monday February 2, 2026, staff continued to research the topics of use requirement in State Statute, defining continual use, and the intent of "public use".

In coordination with Attorney Koehler, he verified that nothing in State Statutes requires a time for the business to open its doors from the time of issuance. *Section 125.10 Wisconsin Statutes allows municipalities to adopt ordinances for anything not contrary to Wisconsin statutes. Since there is no Wisconsin statute requiring the business to be open from the time of issuance, this is up to each municipality for any ordinance they want to adopt.*

Attorney Koehler further verified that *Chapter 125 Wisconsin Statutes regulates when alcoholic beverages cannot be sold but does not require a **minimum** number of “open for hours” business.*

In short, it is up to the Village to determine:

1. If they would like to set a time requirement for the business to initially open its doors for business from the time of issuance;
2. How often the business is required to be open during the hours allowed by State Statute; and
3. If open is intended to mean “open to the public.”

Staff recommends the following to accomplish all 3 of the above conditions **ONLY** for all licenses to sell alcoholic beverages in the Village for which a quota exists limiting the number of such licenses that may be issued.

§ 308-19 Continual use requirements and Conditions.

A. Use standard. Under the authority of § **125.10**, Wis. Stats., as amended from time to time, each and every holder of a “Class B” intoxicating liquor license shall be required to keep the licensed premises open for operation a **minimum of five days per week for at least 150 days during each one-year term of the license** throughout the term of the license (except that the licensed premises may be closed for remodeling from time to time, and except that the licensed premises may be closed for reasonable periods of time when the owner/operator thereof takes vacation; periods of remodeling shall be an exception so long as remodeling is actively pursued during the period when the licensed premises is closed).

As additional conditions for license continuation, the licensed premises must meet the following requirements:

- (1) All usage must be open to the public and may not be used for private rentals closed to the public, unless the licensed premises is of sufficient size with separate space that could be set aside for one-day private engagements, while the remaining portion of the licensed premises remains open to the public; and**
- (2) The licensed premises must be open for business to the public within 180 days of license issuance.**

B. Violation. Upon violation of Subsection **A** above, the license shall be revoked according to the procedure set forth under § **308-18** of this article, or in the alternative, the license shall be nonrenewed according to the terms and provisions of § **308-18** of this article.

§ 308-18 Nonrenewal, suspension or revocation of licenses.

B. Abandonment of premises. Any licensee holding a license to sell alcoholic beverages who abandons such business shall forfeit any right or preference he/she may have to the holding of or renewal of such license. Abandonment shall be sufficient grounds for revocation of any alcoholic beverage license. The closing of the licensed premises for at least six months shall be prima facie evidence of the abandonment, unless extended by the Village Board. **All persons issued a license to sell alcoholic beverages in the Village for which a quota exists limiting the number of such licenses that may be issued by the Village shall cause such business described in such license to be operated on the premises described in such license for at least 150 days during each one-year ~~the~~ terms of such license**, unless such license is issued for a term of less than 180 days, in which event this subsection shall not apply.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

This is for discussion only. Staff will continue to capture all recommendations and bring an amended ordinance to a future meeting for approval.

<p>EXPLANATION: With a desire to provide secure outdoor storage area and a secure impound lot, the property owner of 571 Marcella Street has submitted a site review application to add a roughly 6,000 square foot outdoor storage/vehicle impound lot to the back of the property. Said area would be surrounded by a six to seven foot tall chain link fence that is fully screened by either slats or mesh.</p> <p>Most notably, this property houses Brand Image and Apparel or BIA in the front office space but is also the base for Bob's Towing. Not only for best practice, but some contracts require a secure area during the statutorily retention period by the State of Wisconsin.</p> <p>Said property is zoned, I-1 Industrial Limited and within the Kimberly Industrial Park. Staff finds no concerns with the proposal.</p> <p>ADDITIONAL COMMENTS</p> <p>At the Village Plan Commission meeting on February 17, 2026, there was conversation in regards to the type of screening used in conjunction with the chain link fence as well as inquires into containment methods for the proposed use. The Plan Commission felt if the type of vehicles to be stored include any wrecked vehicles that the fence should be fully screened with slats. If the vehicles were just being impounded but in an operable state, either the slats or the mesh would suffice.</p> <p>Along these similar lines with the concern of wrecked vehicles was the containment of any type of fluids or DNR type of approvals. This was a shared sediment with the Fire Department. The following was further clarified by the applicant following the Plan Commission meeting and found to be acceptable to the Fire Department:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;"><i>The fenced storage area is intended solely for the temporary holding of towed vehicles associated with normal towing and recovery operations. This may occasionally include vehicles that have been involved in accidents; however, the site will not be used as a salvage yard, dismantling facility, or long-term storage location. No vehicle dismantling, fluid draining, or repair activities will occur within the fenced area.</i></p>

With respect to containment and regulatory compliance:

- **Fluids:** Any vehicle that presents an active fluid leak is addressed immediately in accordance with industry best practices. This includes the use of absorbent materials, drip pans, and prompt removal or transfer as necessary. Vehicles with significant fluid loss are not left unattended. Most vehicles with fluid loss have already depleted their fluids before leaving the scene of the accident.
- **DNR compliance:** All operations are conducted in compliance with applicable Wisconsin DNR requirements. No bulk fluid storage or disposal takes place on site.
- **Fire Code:** Vehicles are stored in a manner consistent with fire code spacing and access requirements. No hazardous materials or fuel storage is proposed within the fenced area.
- **Screening:** The proposed fencing will provide visual screening and site control, preventing unauthorized access while maintaining a clean and orderly appearance.

*The intent is to provide a **secure, controlled, short-term storage area** that supports existing towing operations without introducing new or expanded industrial activity beyond what is already permitted.*

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Confirm the Plan Commission recommendation for the approval of the Site Review Plan for 571 Marcella Street as it relates to the addition of a secured outdoor storage/impound lot in the rear of the property with the following conditions:

1. The fence including any screening shall be maintained and properly secured at all times.
2. The outdoor storage/impound lot shall not be used or converted into a junk yard/salvage yard.
3. Any dumpster or refuse containers shall be screened within the fenced area or an additional enclosure shall be provided.

ADDED CONDITION FROM THE PLAN COMMISSION AND FIRE DEPARTMENT

4. The fence shall be fully screened from off-site view with a slatted chain link fence.
5. The Fire Department shall be permitted to inspect the enclosed area for compliance upon a reasonable request.

I am the owner of the commercial property located at **571 Marcela Street** in the Village of Kimberly. I am submitting the enclosed **Narrative of Proposed Use** for review in connection with a proposed site modification at the property, which is located within the **I-1 Industrial District**.

Narrative of Proposed Use**Property Address: 571 Marcela Street****Zoning District: I-1 Industrial District****Village of Kimberly, Wisconsin**

I am the owner of the property located at 571 Marcela Street in the Village of Kimberly. The subject property is located within the I-1 Industrial District and is developed with a legally existing multi-tenant commercial/industrial building currently occupied by three (3) tenants. The site includes an existing paved parking lot that serves tenant and operational needs.

Existing Use

The property is currently used for lawful commercial and industrial purposes consistent with the intent of the I-1 District. The building, parking areas, and site circulation are established and continue to function without adverse impact to surrounding properties.

Proposed Use Description

The proposed improvement consists of fencing a portion of the rear area of the existing parking lot for use as secure, accessory outdoor storage of motor vehicles that have been towed as part of normal business operations. This fenced storage area is intended to function as an accessory use that is subordinate to the principal use of the property and consistent with industrial zoning allowances.

Details of the Proposed Improvement

- The fenced vehicle storage area will be located entirely in the rear portion of the site, away from street frontage and public view.
- The fencing will be a permanent, professionally installed enclosure that complies with Village requirements related to height, materials, placement, and screening.
- Vehicles stored within the fenced area will be temporary in nature and will not be dismantled, repaired, salvaged, or offered for sale on site.
- No outdoor mechanical work, fluid draining, or hazardous material handling will occur.
- The proposal does not include additional buildings, expansion of existing structures, or changes in tenant occupancy.
- Existing parking, drive aisles, fire access, and tenant operations will be maintained in compliance with Village standards.
- All activities will comply with Village of Kimberly ordinances, state regulations, and applicable safety requirements.


Compatibility With I-1 District Intent


Conclusion


